

# AI Test Results from testers.ai



The TestRigor app, specifically its HOME page, reveals a number of concerning issues. The "Failed to Load Resource - DNS Resolution Error" and "Resource Loading Failures (net::ERR\_NAME\_NOT\_RESOLVED)" point to underlying problems with network performance and resource availability. Broken and duplicate links within the navigation menu severely impact usability. Furthermore, accessibility is compromised by missing alt text for images and ARIA attributes for menu dropdowns. Outdated copyright notices and resource URLs indicate a lack of ongoing maintenance. Finally, the app fails to be transparent on data collection on third-party tracking.

### Best Aspects

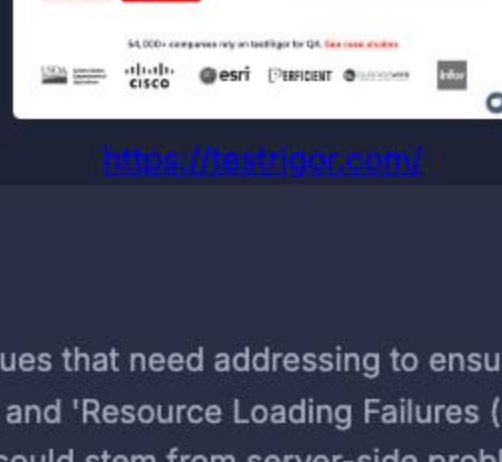
The data only exposes HOME page issues, and assumes that the other pages of the application is sound in functionality and has no performance or stability related issues. Given this, the app is able to function, even though there are some basic quality issues on its landing page.

### Areas for Improvement

The most troubling aspects are the network related performance issues, broken links, and accessibility violations, which degrade user experience, accessibility compliance, and trust.

### Detailed Analysis

The HOME page of the TestRigor app has several issues that need addressing to ensure a positive user experience. Resource loading errors like "Failed to Load Resource - DNS Resolution Error" and "Resource Loading Failures (net::ERR\_NAME\_NOT\_RESOLVED)" immediately degrade performance and availability. These issues could stem from server-side problems or client-side configuration errors, either way these are serious. Navigation is hampered by "Broken Links in Navigation Menu" and "Duplicate Links in Navigation Menus," making it harder for users to find what they need. Accessibility shortcomings, indicated by "Missing Alt Text for Images" and "Missing ARIA attributes for Menu Dropdowns," create barriers for users with disabilities, violating WCAG guidelines. A lack of transparency regarding data collection is indicated by "Lack of Data Collection Transparency Regarding Third-Party Tracking," failing to comply with GDPR standards. "Missing Screenshot Preview on Mobile" adds to user frustration, indicating layout inconsistencies across different devices. Finally, "Outdated Copyright Notice" and "Outdated Resource URL: Image uploaded in September 2024" suggest a lapse in regular maintenance and updates.

### Key Suggestions

- Implement automated link checking and accessibility testing as part of the CI/CD pipeline.
- Conduct regular website audits to identify and fix outdated content and broken links.
- Improve monitoring and alerting for resource loading errors to proactively address performance issues.

### Priority Improvements

1. Investigate and resolve the root cause of "Failed to Load Resource - DNS Resolution Error" and "Resource Loading Failures (net::ERR\_NAME\_NOT\_RESOLVED)" to improve page load times and resource availability. Implement monitoring to prevent recurrence.
2. Audit and fix all broken and duplicate links in the navigation menu to enhance usability. Consider automated link checking as part of the build process.
3. Add missing alt text to all images and implement ARIA attributes for menu dropdowns to improve accessibility and comply with WCAG guidelines. Conduct accessibility testing to validate.
4. Audit and update outdated copyright notices and resource URLs. Implement a process for regularly reviewing and updating such content.
5. Implement a detailed policy on data collection transparency regarding third-party tracking.

#### Missing Screenshot Preview on Mobile

Missing or Out-Of Content | Layout Shifting

#### Why is this a bug?

The large screenshot demonstrating the product UI is completely missing in the mobile view. This is a significant omission, as it removes a key visual element that helps users understand the product. The layout shift doesn't account for the removal of the element, or re-positioning to show on smaller devices.

#### Suggested Fix

Implement responsive design adjustments to either scale down the screenshot appropriately for mobile view or replace it with a mobile-friendly version or alternative visual representation. Ensure it is still clearly visible and informative.

#### Why Fix This?

The missing screenshot degrades the user experience on mobile devices by removing a crucial visual element that aids in understanding the product's functionality and appearance.

#### Broken Links in Navigation Menu

#### Why is this a bug?

Several links in the navigation menu, specifically those under the 'AI Testing', 'Features', and 'Resources' dropdowns, point to '#' which means they are non-functional or lead to the top of the page. This hinders navigation and frustrates users.

#### Suggested Fix

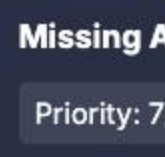
Replace the '#' links with valid URLs that point to the correct destinations. Ensure all navigation links are functional and lead to the intended pages.

#### Why Fix This?

Broken links in the navigation menu make it difficult for users to access important content and features, leading to a poor user experience and potential loss of engagement.

#### Missing Alt Text for Images

Priority: 7/10 Confidence: 8/10

WCAG | accessibility

#### Why is this a bug?

Images without alt text are inaccessible to screen reader users, violating WCAG guidelines. This prevents users with visual impairments from understanding the content and purpose of the images. While the provided page elements do not contain specific image details, it is highly probable that numerous images across the page are missing alt text. For instance, the company logo and various other visual elements likely lack alt attributes.

#### Suggested Fix

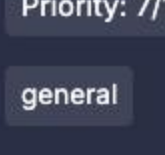
Add descriptive alt text to all meaningful images on the page. Ensure that the alt text accurately conveys the content and purpose of each image. Decorative images should have an empty alt attribute (alt="") to be properly ignored by screen readers.

#### Why Fix This?

Missing alt text makes the website inaccessible to users with visual impairments, leading to a poor and non-inclusive user experience. Addressing this issue is essential for WCAG compliance.

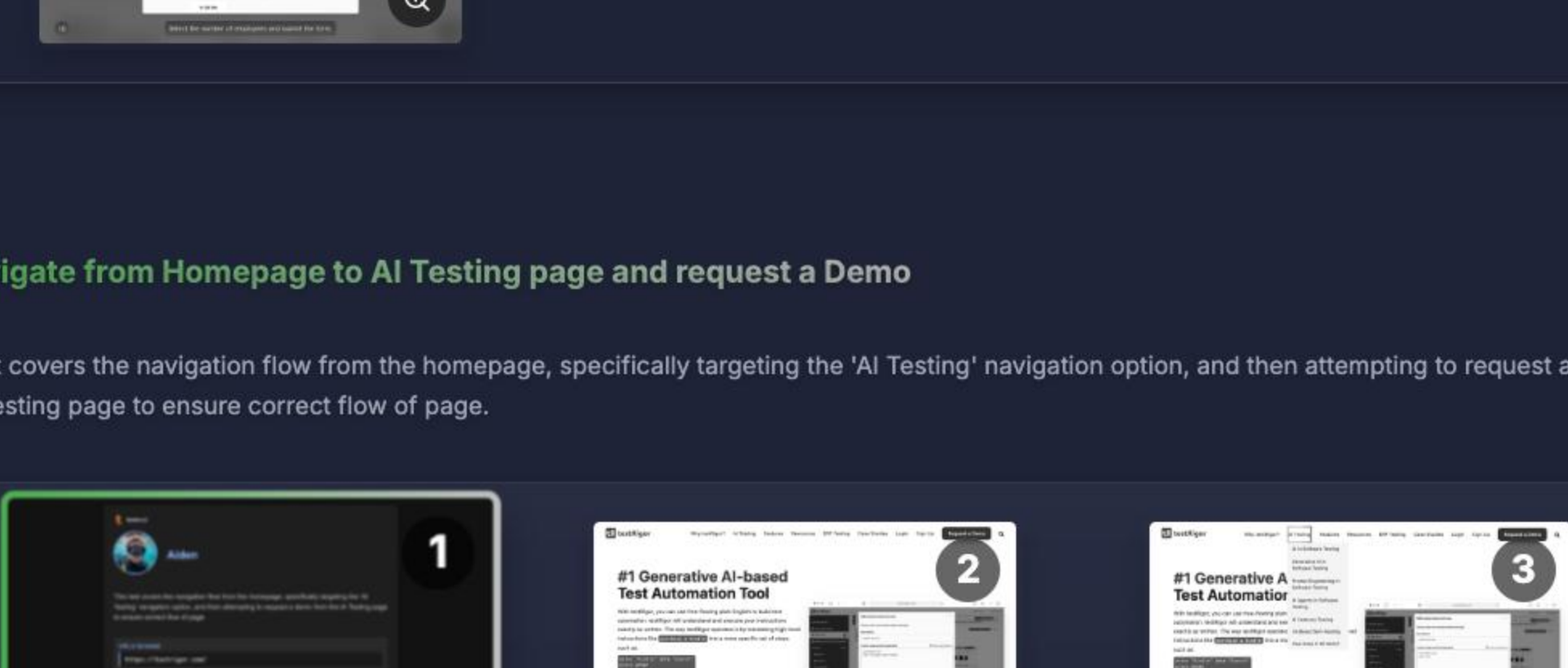
