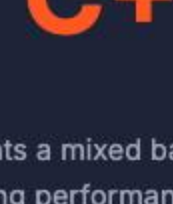

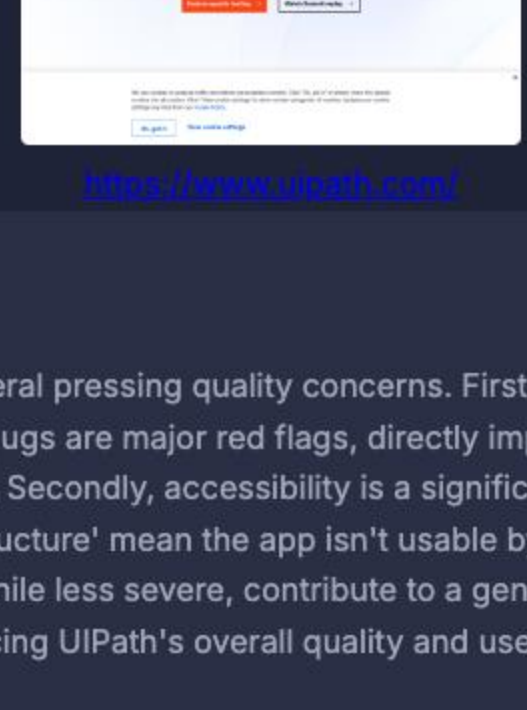
Best Aspects

- Implement a style guide to improve UI consistency and elegance.

Priority Improvements

1. Resolve DNS resolution errors causing failed resource loads on the HOME page. This directly impacts performance and usability.
2. Implement missing alt text for all images on the HOME page. This is a fundamental accessibility requirement.
3. Increase text contrast to meet WCAG standards on the HOME page to make the app usable to more users.
4. Correct the heading structure to ensure proper semantic organization of the HOME page content.
5. Review and update the link text for 'Explore' to be more descriptive and remove ambiguity on the HOME page.
6. Fix the incorrect copyright year range displayed on the HOME page.

Why is this a bug?

The copyright notice at the bottom of the page states '© 2005-2025 UIPath. All rights reserved.' Since it is currently 2025, the copyright year should reflect the current year; having '2005-2025' indicates that it may not be updated correctly or dynamically.

Suggested Fix
Update the copyright notice to '© 2005-2025 UIPath. All rights reserved.' This should ideally be dynamically updated each year.

Why Fix This?
To ensure legal compliance and reflect the current copyright status of the website's content. An outdated copyright notice can undermine user trust and potentially lead to legal issues.

Countdown Timer Inaccuracy

Why is this a bug?
The countdown timer in the button bar shows '18Days 21Hours 20Minutes' until the Agentic Automation launch. Since I was created and still think it is 2024, then the time to the event is likely not correct as it is currently 2025-04-11. This presents inaccurate information to the user and thus a usability issue. It needs to dynamically reflect the real time left to the event.

Suggested Fix
Implement a JavaScript-based countdown timer that dynamically updates the time remaining until the event based on current date and time. Regularly synchronize with a reliable time server to ensure accuracy.

Why Fix This?
Incorrect countdown information misleads users, decreasing the trustworthiness and credibility of the site.

Insufficient Text Contrast

WCAG Text Contrast

Why is this a bug?
Several text elements on the page do not meet the minimum contrast ratio requirements as per WCAG guidelines. This makes it difficult for users with low vision or color blindness to read the text content effectively. Example: The text in the footer, or the text inside the promotional card link.

Suggested Fix
Increase the contrast ratio between the text color and the background color for all text elements to meet WCAG AA or AAA standards. This can be done by adjusting the color palette or using tools to check and correct contrast ratios.

Why Fix This?
Improving text contrast will make the content more readable for users with visual impairments, ensuring that they can access and understand the information presented on the webpage.

Navigation Links Missing in Mobile View

Why is this a bug?
The navigation links (Explore, Platform, Solutions, Resources, About, Contact us, Sign in) visible in the large browser window are not present in the mobile view. The absence of these links significantly hinders the user's ability to navigate the website on a mobile device.

Suggested Fix
Implement a responsive navigation menu (e.g., a hamburger menu) to ensure that all navigation links are accessible in the mobile view.

Why Fix This?
Missing navigation links severely impact usability, making it difficult for users to access different sections of the website on mobile devices.

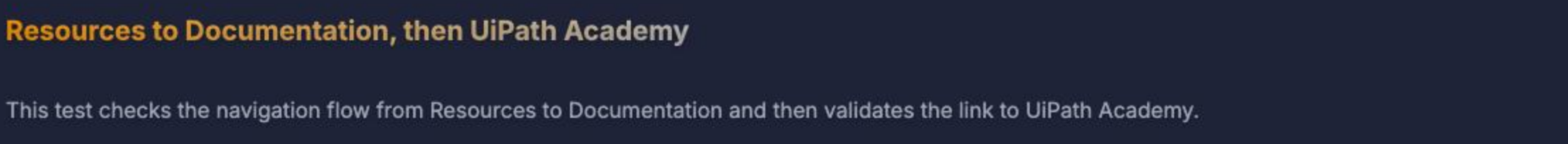

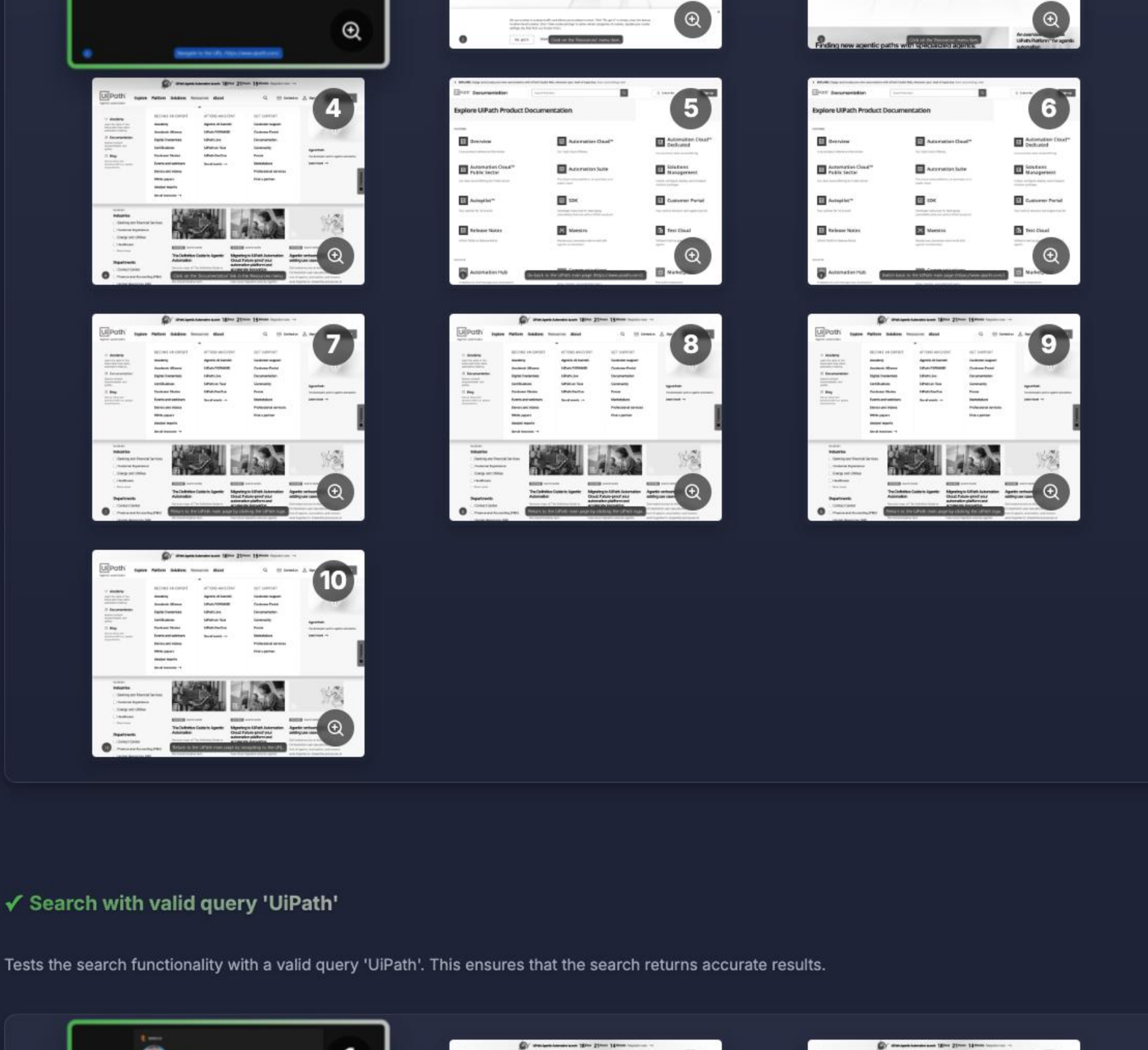

This test validates that accepting the cookie policy allows the user to proceed to explore the agentic testing page. The test is important to ensure that the cookie banner does not block core functionality after consent.



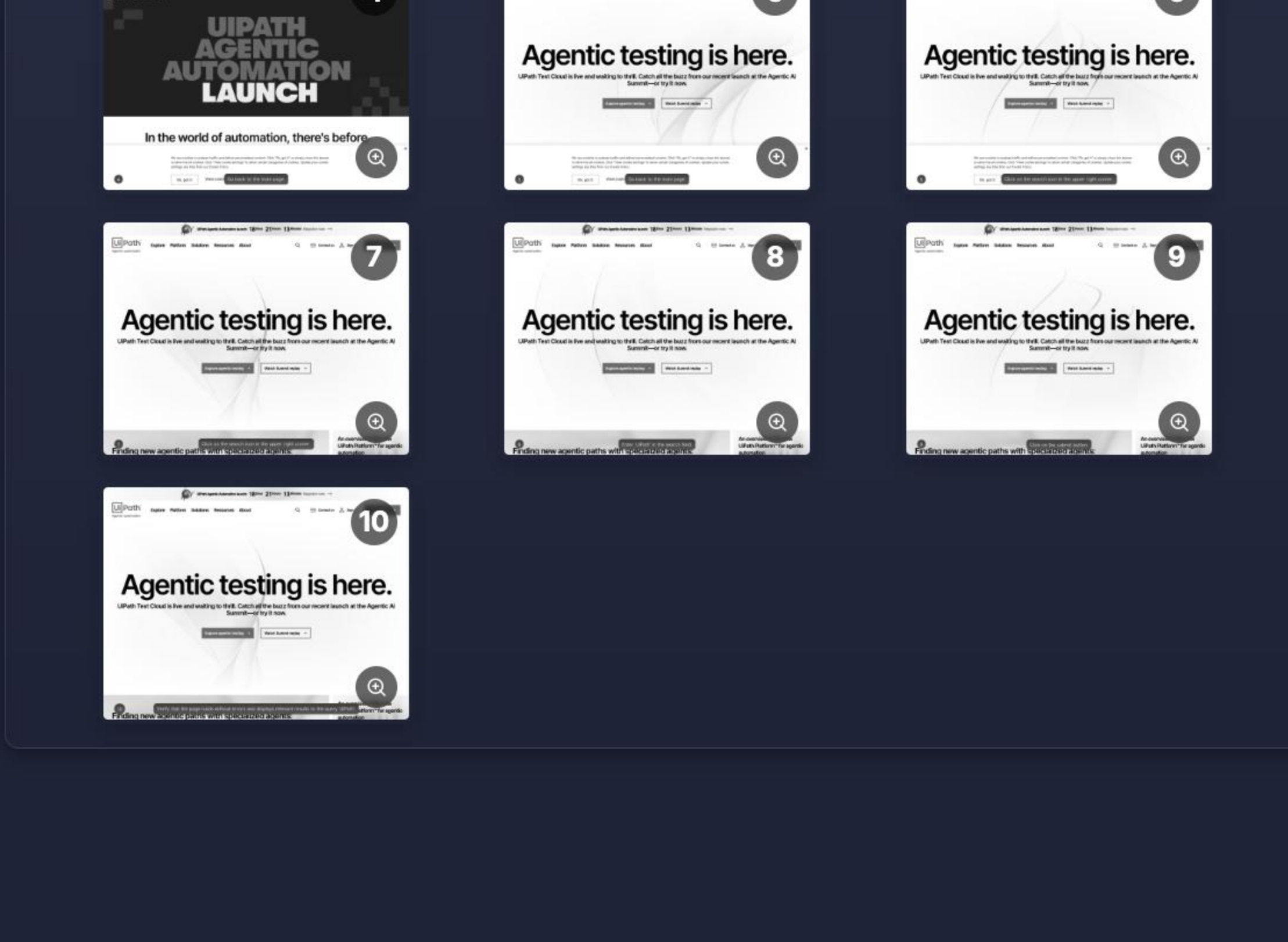

This test checks the navigation flow from Resources to Documentation and then validates the link to UIPath Academy.

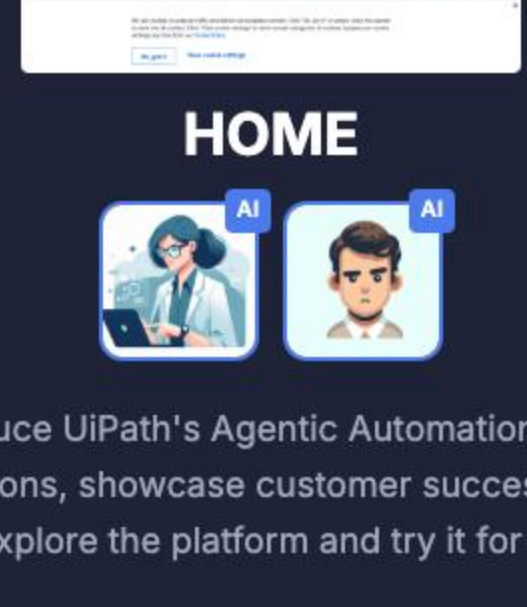
